All are welcome to submit a poster presentation idea for the 2nd Annual Kentucky Local Foods Summit on February 26, held in the UK Student Center. We especially encourage undergraduate students, graduate students, and student organizations doing research, outreach, and service projects related to local food systems.

Local food systems span everything from farm to fork, and they span technical, business, behavioral, and societal aspects. The common link is food produced and consumed by people in a limited geographic area.

Posters will be displayed in the Student Center Ballroom all day during the Kentucky Local Food Systems Summit. We ask presenters to be present from 12:45 to 1:15 for discussion as Summit attendees view the posters.

How to submit a poster idea: In one page or less, please include the following:

- the purpose, activities, and outcomes of the work you would like to present
- how the work relates to local food systems
- the presenter's name, collaborators' names if any, and the department, group, or organization you are affiliated with
- how you will make the poster visually appealing and interesting to a general audience.

Leigh will contact you soon after you submit your poster presentation idea to let you know if it was selected. The main selection criteria are closeness of fit with the Summit's local food systems theme, diversity across the many aspects of local food systems, and diversity across the many types of work and people involved in local food systems.

If your presentation idea is accepted:

- Leigh will send you a PowerPoint poster template that you can modify in any way except the 24"x36" size
- Please send the file containing your finalized poster to Leigh (leigh.maynard@uky.edu) by January 24
- Leigh will coordinate printing and temporary mounting of your poster on posterboard free of charge. Tripods will be supplied for displaying posters.
